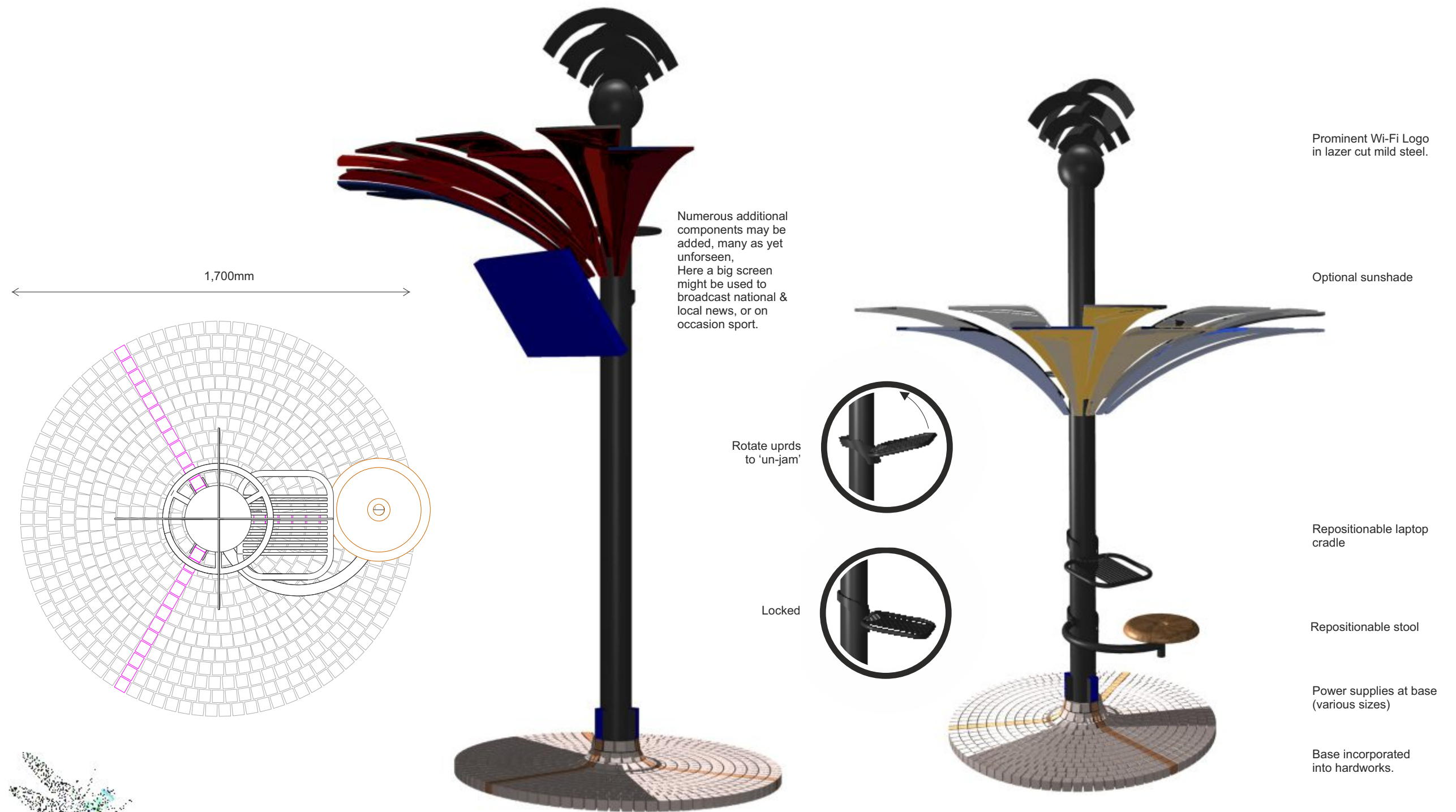


WORKSPACE AS STREET FURNITURE

The proposal is for simple & robust street furniture.

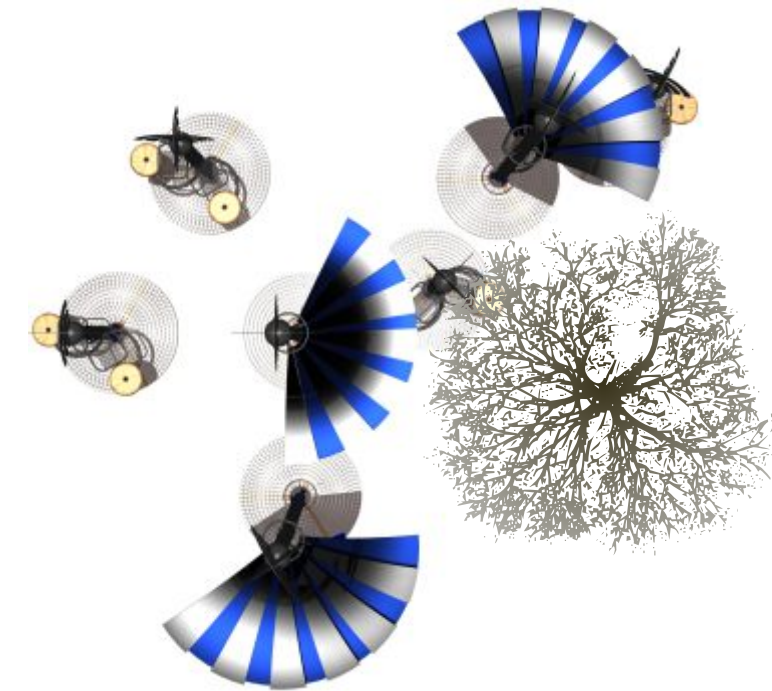
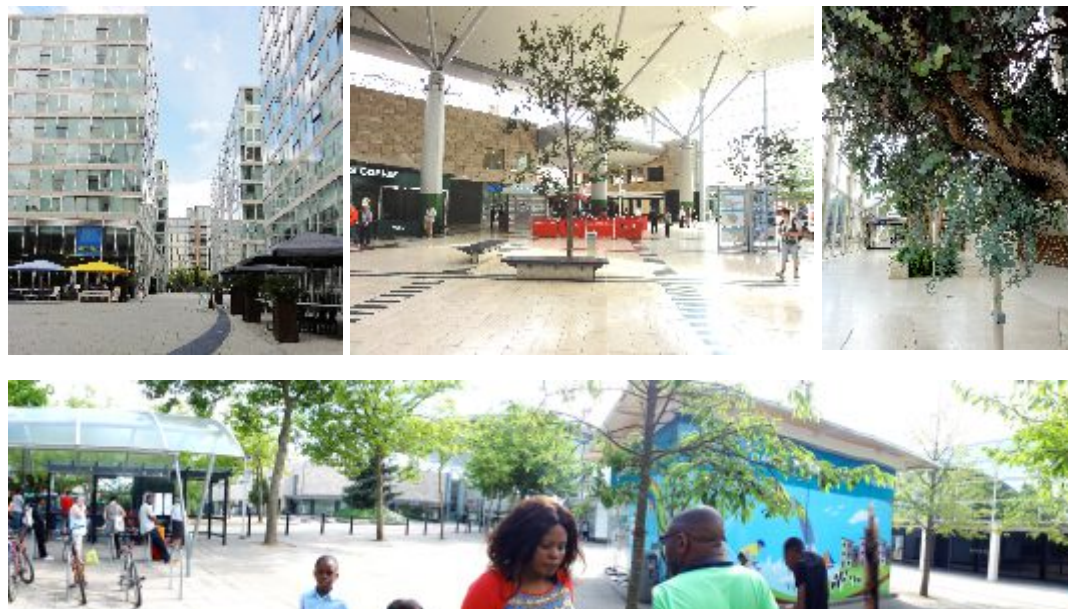


W O R K S P A C E A S S T R E E T F U R N I T U R E
